A. DEPOSIT: Deposits and payments are outlined on each trip flyer. Send the initial deposit for each trip with this Trip and Tour Agreement and a color copy of your passport (if the trip goes out of the country) or driver's license if trip is in the US, to address listed above.

B. IDENTIFICATION: Each person **Must Have** an Up-To-Date (Valid) State issued Pictured I.D. for travel within the U.S. or an **Up-To-Date (Valid) PASSPORT** for presentation at the airport for check-in. Customs requires a passport for trips out of the country. (**See Notice below**) No refunds will be made to any passengers whose participation is affected due to failure to possess proper identification.

C. CANCELLATION AND/OR CHARGES: The Warren Ski Club reserves the right to withdraw the tour, to refuse to accept or retain any person as a member of the tour at any time, or make changes in the published itinerary whenever in their sole judgment conditions warrant. Applicant shall be liable to the Warren Ski Club for any monies expended or paid by the Warren Ski Club over and above payments made by applicant. The Warren Ski Club may add supplemental costs such as but not limited to fuel surcharges, taxes, and airport departure charges or currency rate changes.

The Club reserves the right to refuse to accept or retain any person as a participant in an event or trip at any time.
- B. **Responsibility.** The Club is acting as an agent for all Participants and shall not be liable for any delay or inconvenience during an activity or trip, any loss of or damage to property, personal injury, death, accident, or illness during an event or trip. Participation in all activities are at the participant's own risk.
- C. **Refunds.** If a Participant cancels after a payment has been made, the Participant must notify the Trip Leader or Host in writing and receive written acknowledgement of said cancellation to receive any possible reimbursement. If a Participant cancels and the Club can fill your spot, you may be refunded any amounts the Club is reimbursed, less a club handling fee. You will be charged a \$50.00 handling fee for trips costing less than \$1,000.00 and \$100.00 handling fee for trips or events costing more than \$1,000.00, or as specified on the trip/event flyer.
