Sunday: Stop at Wayne Gretzky Estates! Estimated time to arrive home will be dependent on the border crossing, but we are hopeful to arrive back by 7:00pm-ish.

CANADIAN INADMISSABILITY FOR BORDER CROSSING

→ If you've been convicted of certain offenses in the United States, you may be denied access into Canada! See a condensed list on the back of this flyer. If any of these offenses apply to you, you decide to come on this trip, and get caught, **WE WILL LEAVE YOU AT THE BORDER** and you will need to find your own way home. You will not be issued a refund!

A. PAYMENT: Send \$50.00 non-refundable deposit in with this signed Trip Agreement and a copy of you your non-expired passport to hold your spot. ***Passport must not expire within the next 6 months.*** Deposits will be accepted until the trip is full. Only current 2026 - 2027 Warren Ski Club members who make a payment in full, with a signed agreement will be guaranteed a seat on the trip. Each person must fill out and sign this trip application. Final payments will be due on or before **September 1st, 2026**. After this date, you will be responsible for payment of the entire trip at a two person per room rate. Make checks payable to the: **WARREN SKI CLUB**

B. IDENTIFICATION: A driver's license is required in addition to your non-expired passport!

C. CANCELLATION AND/OR CHANGES: The Warren Ski Club reserves the right to withdraw the trip, or make changes in the published itinerary whenever, in their sole judgment, conditions warrant. The Warren Ski Club reserves the right to refuse to accept or retain any person as a member of the trip at any time.

D. RESPONSIBILITY: The Warren Ski Club is acting as agent for the trip participants and shall not be liable for any loss of or damage to property, for any loss, personal injury, death, accident, delay, inconvenience, or any other loss during the trip. Participation and all activities are at participant's own risk.

E. REFUNDS: A full refund will be made to participants if The Warren Ski Club cancels this trip. A full refund (minus the \$50.00 deposit) will be made to participants if the participant's spot is sold up to two weeks before the scheduled trip.

F. COVID-19: The Warren Ski Club cannot prevent you from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 or any of its variants while on our trip. If you choose to travel with us and partake in the planned activities, you may be exposing yourself to and increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19. By signing this Trip Agreement, you choose to accept the risk of contracting COVID-19 and release and waive your right to bring suit against the Warren Ski Club in connection with exposure, infection, and/or spread of COVID-19 related to participating in this trip. You also agree to abide by any and all protocols set forth by the United States government or Canada that may be in place at the time of this trip, including, but not limited to wearing a mask.

CANADIAN LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

→ ***A Canadian immigration officer will decide if you can enter Canada when you arrive at a port of entry. You may be denied access to Canada and ineligible for this trip if you have been convicted of the following:***

"Drunk driving or impaired driving convictions (even if they are recorded as a traffic offense) where the blood alcohol reading is 0.081% or above – or a breath reading of 0401mgms/L or above, will make you inadmissible to Canada. While generally less serious in the United States, DUI convictions in Canada are much more serious offenses under the Canadian Criminal Code.

Other common convictions that may make a person inadmissible to Canada are: reckless or dangerous driving, common assault, street racing, hinder or resist a police officer in the execution of duty, **possession of a banned substance****, supply/trafficking of drugs/banned substance (including cannabis), shoplifting (theft), fraud, or criminal damage, to name a few. Some offenses, such as murder, home invasions/burglary, armed robbery, rape, etc., are categorized as Serious Criminality when evaluating Canadian inadmissibility. When such is the case, the decision to grant admission into Canada cannot be made solely by an examining officer, but they must refer the case to a Manager/Supervisor for determination." → ****You cannot legally bring marijuana-based items (including CBD oils, edibles, vapes, or any cannabis product) into Canada.** The Cannabis Act, legalizing and regulating cannabis (marijuana), creates a strict legal framework for controlling the production, distribution, sale and possession of cannabis in Canada.

Transporting cannabis across the border in any form – including any oils containing THC or cannabidiol (CBD) - without a permit or exemption authorized by Health Canada remains a serious criminal offense subject to arrest and prosecution, despite the legalization of cannabis in Canada. The prohibition applies regardless of:

The amount of cannabis you have with you, whether you hold a medical document authorizing the use of cannabis for medical purposes, whether you are travelling from an area with legalized or decriminalized cannabis.
